<b>Hook</b> : 1 – 3 sentences used to capture the reader's interest in the essay. Use an "imagine statement" or heartbreaking statistic, brief story or quote.

Bridge: After capturing the reader's attention, present the necessary background the reader need understand the topic. What is this article about? What is the issue? What should your reader expect to understand about this topic? (Why is Fair Trade a big deal?)	
<b>Thesis:</b> The last sentence in your introduction paragraph that states your opinion/feelings about topic and your reasons of support. It is a one sentence summary of your essay.	the

Main body (there is no set number of paragraphs, so you must decide how to break up your article into logical paragraphs) What is at the heart of your story?

Things that you should definitely include in your blog:

- Fair Trade (define it, how does it work?, why is it important to look for this in cocoa products?)
- Child labor (explain the conditions of children working on cocoa farms, why is this necessary?)
- Slave labor (how do they get away with this?!)

- Environmental impact of irresponsible cocoa farming
- Most importantly, what can your peers do to make sure the cocoa farmers have a better life? Brainstorm your list of relevant text evidence that you want to include in your newspaper article here. Remember, you need a minimum of **7 pieces of evidence from the videos, articles, class discussion/notes, or other websites you've used for research**. These can be summarized or quoted directly in your paper.
